Classes and Regulations

III. Goats

DELETE

~~2. All goats, except Angoras and Boer Goats showing in the breeding show, must be dehorned and healed prior to the show. All Market Goats, regardless of breed must be dehorned with a maximum of 1 inch re-growth allowed or they can have scurs that are a maximum of 1 inch in length. All Market Goats regardless of breed must be dehorned.~~

ADD: It will goat exhibitor's choice to show animals horned or dehorned.

V. Market Hogs

Procedure change: All market hogs will be checked prior to entering the ring on show day for the use of products other than water on their skin.

C. Participation

6. All horses must be accompanied by a current vaccination record from a Licensed Veterinarian or a self-made shot record with a receipt for the purchased vaccines attached. ~~These must turned into the Senior Fairboard Office.~~ **ADD: These must be turned into the Extension Office by August 10, 2018.** Required health certifications include vaccinations for equine influenza and tetanus.

D. Horse Show Classes

Divide Ground Roping into a Jr. and Sr. Division (Senior – ages 14 & up as of Jan. 1st and Junior – ages 13 & under as of Jan. 1st.)
