

Noble County Royalty Expectations

- Promote Noble County Fair by visiting other fairs.
- Meet and greet visiting royalty.
- Attend events and activities Ex: 4th of July BBQ, 4-H winners revies, 4-H kickoff, royalty corner.
- Complete at least 1 community service as royalty
- Participate in royalty fundraisers.
- Work shows and livestock sale at Noble County Fair
- Attend royalty meetings.
- Serve 1 year as a member of Noble County Jr. Fairboard
- Attend Ohio Fair Mangers Convention as royalty.
- Queen **must** participate in Queen of Queens Contest at Convention
- Be yourself and represent Noble County in a positive way.

Rules to run for Royalty

- Contestants must be between the ages of 9 – 18 as of January 1 of the current year.
- Must be a member of at least 1 organization represented by the Noble County Fair
- Entrants must complete an application. Available online or at Noble County 4-H Extension office
- **Application must be returned by July 12th 2024**
- Contestants cannot now or have ever been married, pregnant or an adoptive parent.
- Can not be convicted of a criminal offense or have charges pending.
- Can not use or consume illegal controlled substances or alcohol.
- Previous winners must wait 1 year before applying for the next level.
- No inappropriate social media
- If for any reason you cannot fulfill your responsibilities throughout your reign you will be relinquished of your title and 1st runner up will fill the position and assume responsibility.

Royalty Applications, Judging and Parade

Applications, recommendations and pictures are due July 12th 2024.

If completing online application, please print recommendation paper and return by July 14th. Recommendations must be completed by advisor, teacher, coach or youth leader. Family members may not fill out recommendations. **Only return application portion of packet. Please keep information pages for your records.**

Interviews will take place on July 27th at the Noble County Sr. Fairboard office. They will start at 8am, times will be scheduled after all applications are received. Please dress business/casual for your interview. Scoring will be done based on the following: participation, achievements, leadership, initiative, character, participation in Jr. Fair, poise and personality, personal appearance, recommendations, community service and interview skills. Scrapbooks and resume are not to be brought to interviews.

Parade line up will begin at 5:30 with parade starting at 6:30 pm. Contestant is responsible for their own ride in parade. You may use any type of vehicle you would like; you may even walk if preferred. Pageant will be held behind the courthouse a ½ hour following parade. You will be asked to introduce yourself, what organization you represent and which school you attend. You will then answer an age appropriate "fishbowl" question. Crowning will follow the end of questions.
