## **NOBLE COUNTY 4-H TEEN AMBASSADORS**

## WHAT IS IT?

4-H Teen Ambassadors is an organized program of activities which encourages older 4-H club members to develop new knowledge, skills and attitudes related to leadership and citizenship, while providing the opportunity to meet other 4-H youth from around the county. 4-H Teen Ambassadors will share advice and recommendations to 4-H professionals in order to improve, strengthen, and expand the county 4-H program. The 4-H Teen Ambassadors will work to promote the 4-H program to the greater community through planned activities, school visits and planning the 4-H Kick-Off.

## WHO CAN APPLY?

Any 4-H'er 12-18 years of age as of January 1st and in **at least 7th grade** may apply. Older 4-H'ers may choose to attend most meetings and work for the recognition of completing 1 year of 4-H Teen Ambassadors. Some youth may only be able to attend 1 or 2 meetings per year. Regardless of the circumstances, all older 4-h'ers are invited to every meeting and can come and go as your schedule permits.

#### WHAT ARE 4-H TEEN AMBASSADOR GUIDELINES?

- \* Attend ½ of all regular meetings
- \* Involvement in at least 2 committees or 2 community service projects as Teen Ambassadors
- \* Help at 2 or more County-Wide Activities such as:
  - Miscellaneous Judging
  - Food & Nutrition Judging
  - Clothing Judging
  - Noble County Jr. Fair
  - Officer Training
  - Achievement Night
  - 4-H Camp/Cloverbud Camp
  - 4-H Week Activities (School promotion, record radio PSAs, write article, make posters, etc.)
  - Skillathon/Quality Assurance activities
  - Other activities through-out the year
  - Each year, the group will set goals to achieve in promoting the 4-H program to the greater community through planned activities.
- \* Share leadership information with your own 4-H Club
- Two three members will serve as youth representatives to the Noble County 4-H Council
