Fair Week

As a Junior Fairboard member, you are required to work at least 2 shows and 1 sale shift during the Fair Week.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 12-18 as of Jan. 1, 2026
- Ability to work with minimal supervision and/or know when and where to receive assistance when needed.
- Always demonstrates appropriate behavior.
- Possesses good leadership abilities and responsibilities skills.
- The willingness to promote Junior Fair as an educational opportunity where proper ethics and honesty is valued.

General Responsibilities:

- Assisting with cleanup at the Noble County Fairgrounds both before and during the Noble County Fair.
- Staffing the Junior Fairboard office during designated fair hours to hand out awards.
- Maintaining appropriate records concerning judging, events, prizes and awards at Junior Fair events and activities.
- Assisting with the set-up, maintenance and assignment of animal stalls and display areas.

- Assisting with securing awards, trophies and materials needed to carry out the Noble County Junior Fair.
- Maintaining the Noble County Junior Fairboard as an active, productive organization by:
 - Conducting orderly meetings sufficient to complete assigned tasks.
 - Electing officers based on individual ability, attitude and experience.
 - Provide orientation and assistance for new members.
 - Using appropriate parliamentary procedures to conduct meetings.
 - Keeping accurate and current treasury and secretarial records.
 - Maintaining a current and annually revised constitution and by-laws.
 - Involving all youth organizations and having members actively involved.
- Maintaining active membership in the youth organization which you represent.
- Wearing appropriate clothing and conducting appropriate behavior while serving in the role as a Junior Fairboard member at activities and events related to the Junior Fair.
