

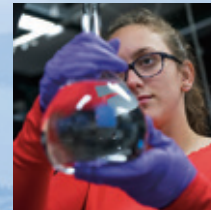
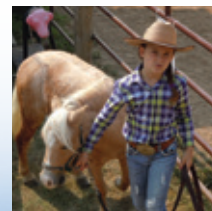

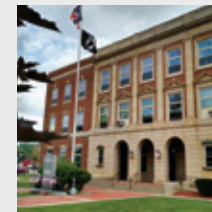

Noble County, Ohio, is a profitable, low-cost business environment in the heart of the state's shale oil and gas region.



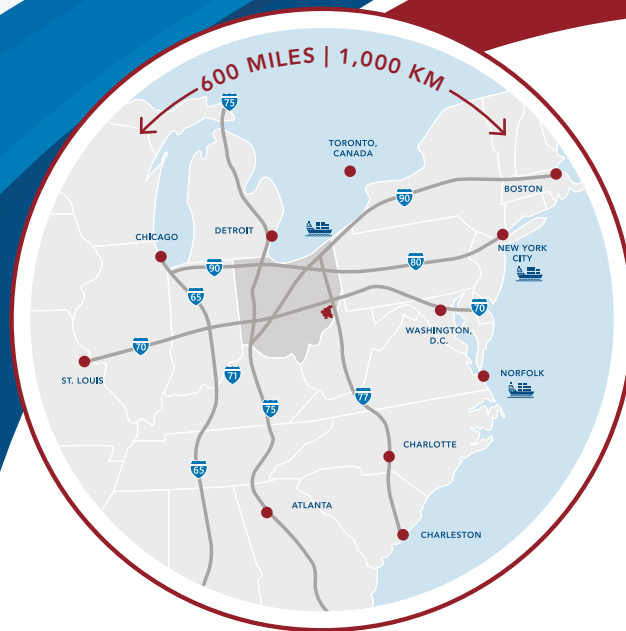
The county boasts available skilled workers, excellent transportation access, sites and buildings, reliable power and other utilities, strong financial incentives, and an excellent quality of life.
