Takeaways

- As of 2021 the region's population **declined by 0.1%** since 2016, falling by 33. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.7%** between 2021 and 2026, losing 262.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs **declined by 9.2%** in Coshocton County, OH from 11,201 to **10,174**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 1.9% by 11.1%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 53.0% to 47.6% between 2016 and 2021**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.3% of Coshocton County, OH residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.1% below the national average), and **10.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

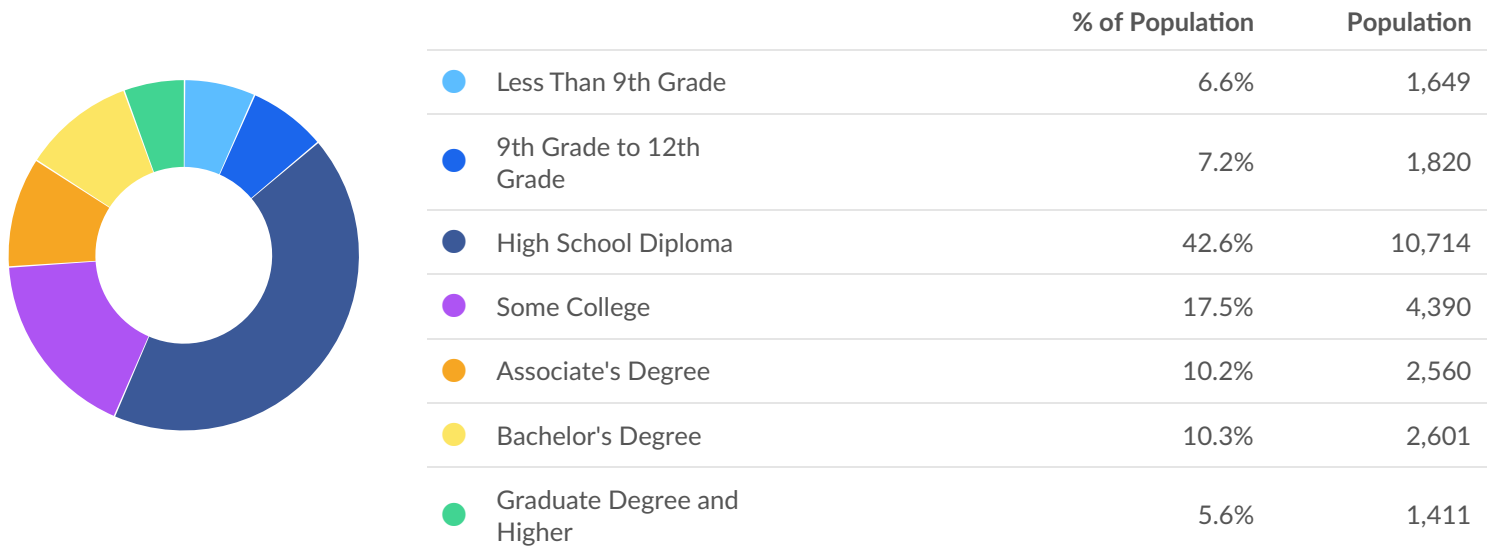

Sep 2022 Labor Force Breakdown



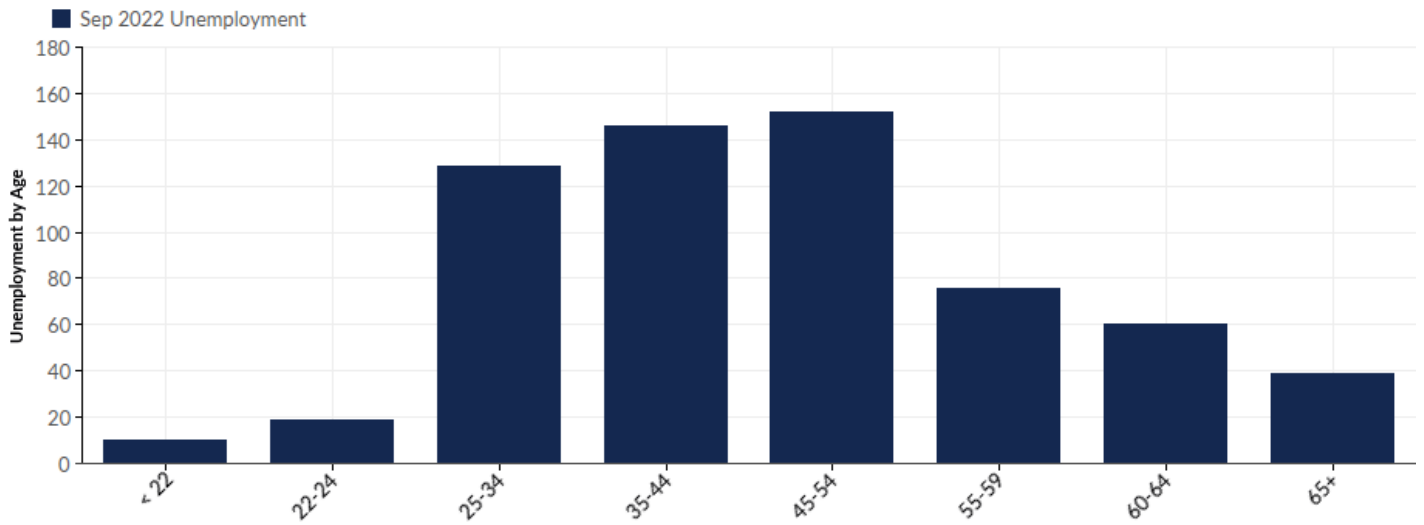
Educational Attainment

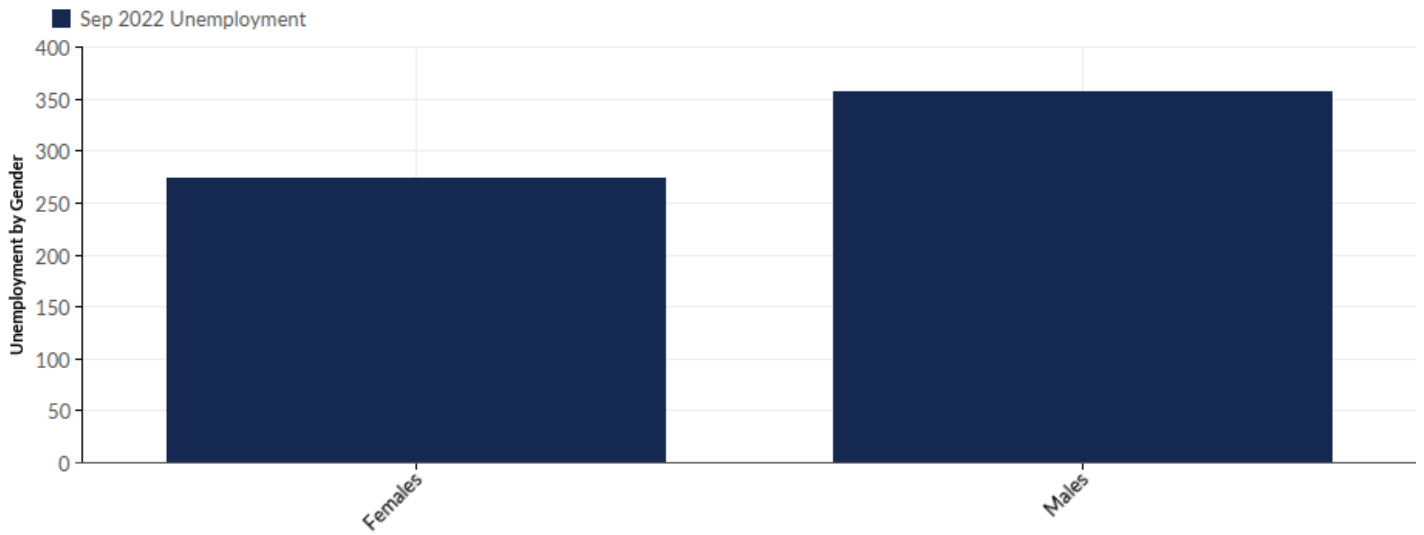

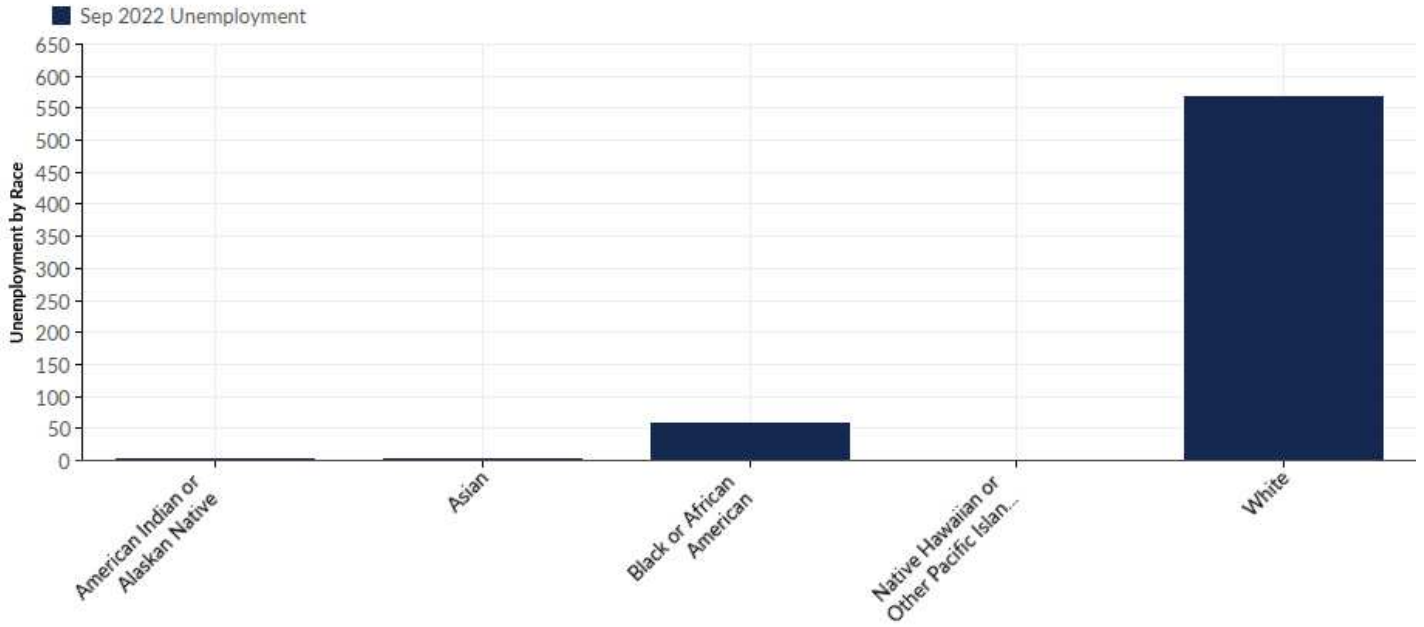

Unemployment by Gender



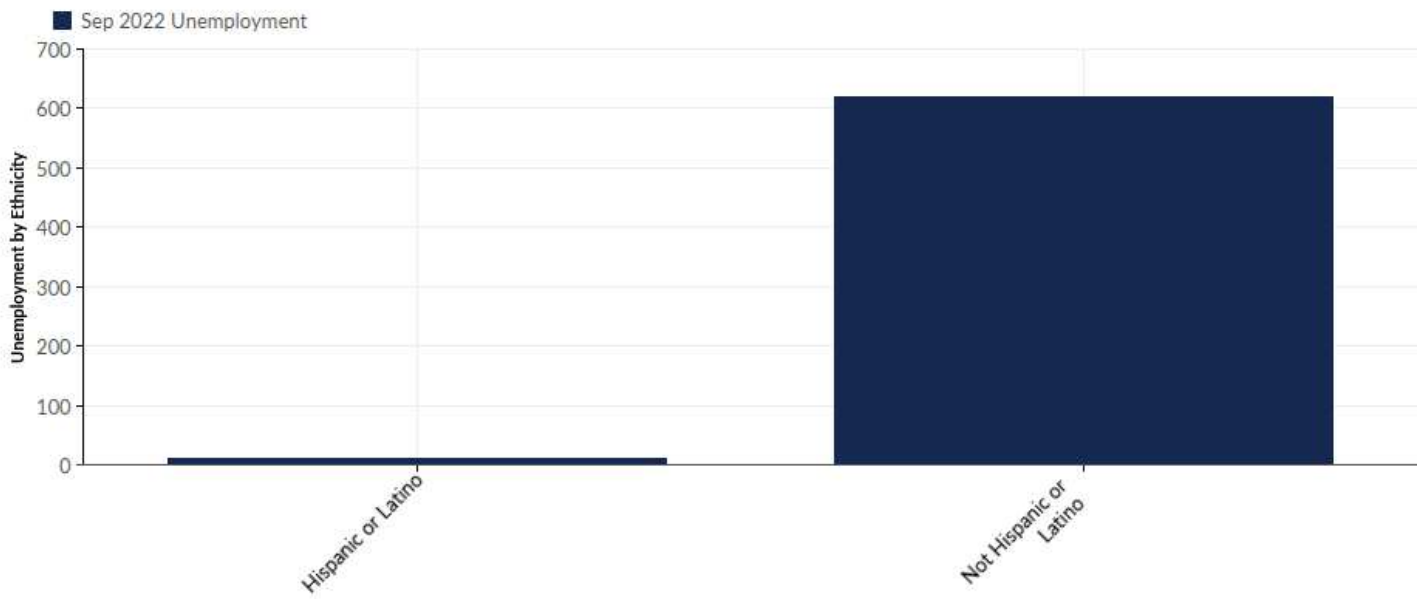

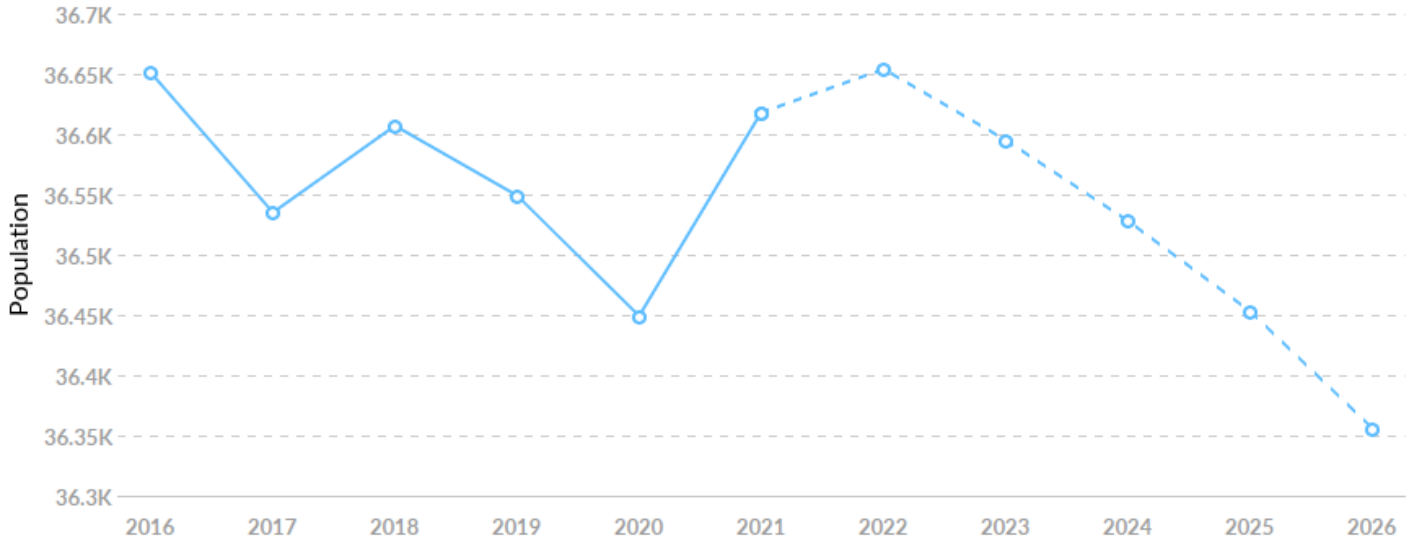

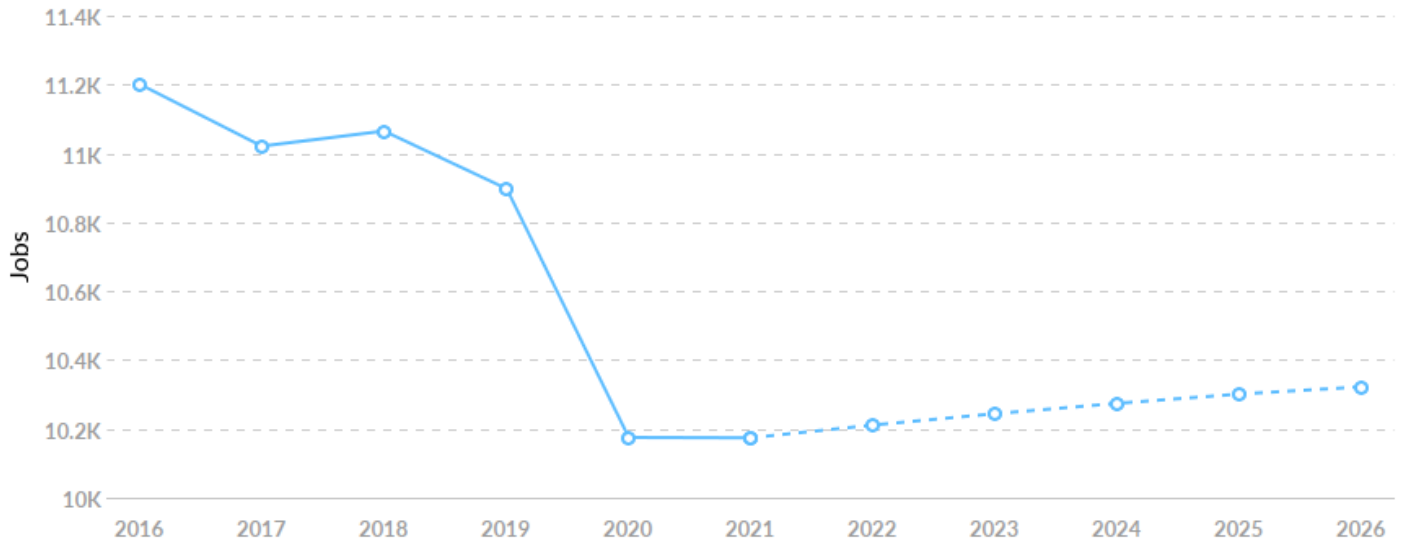

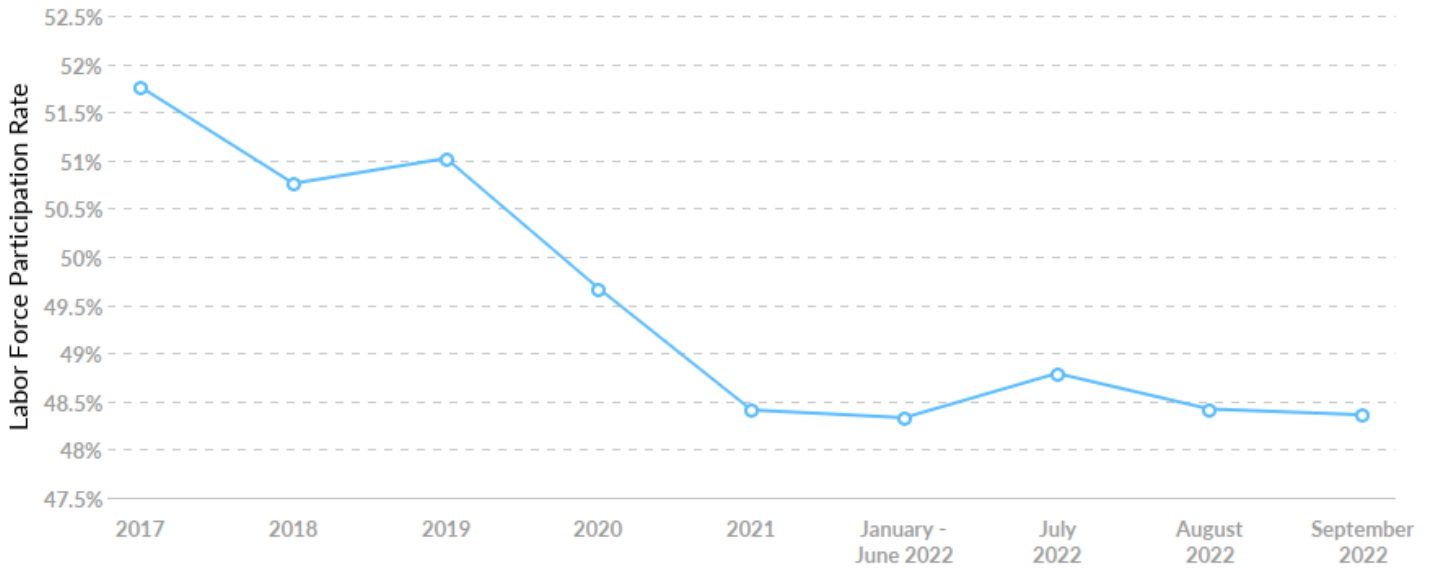
Job Trends

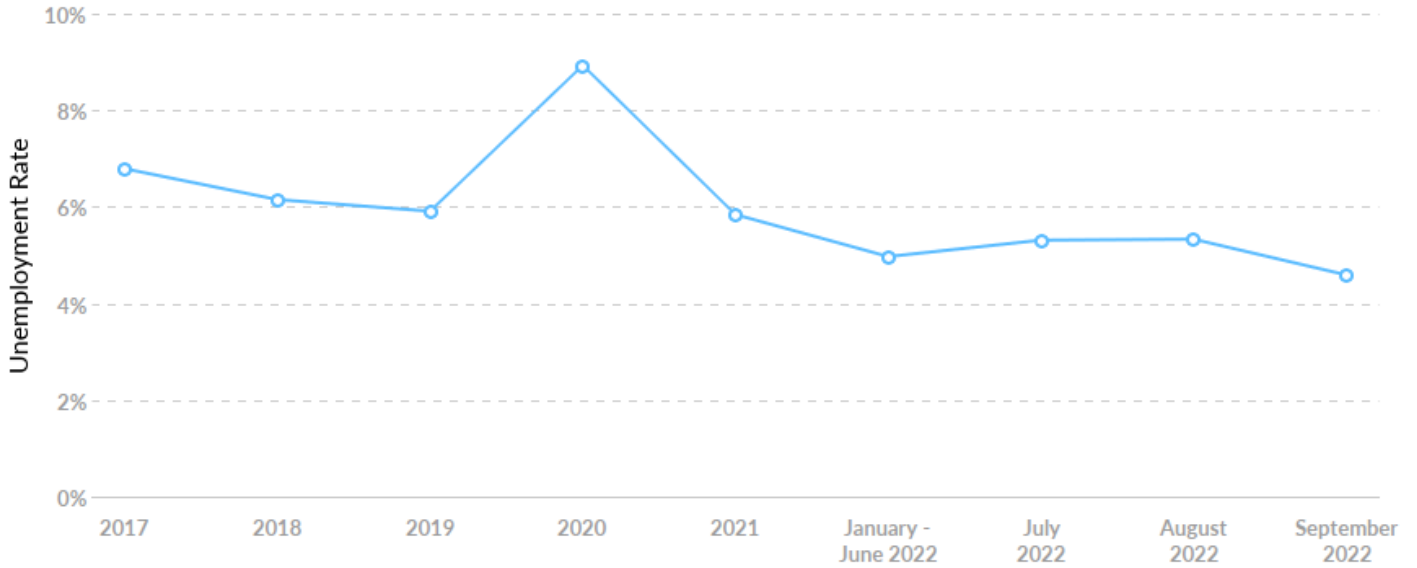

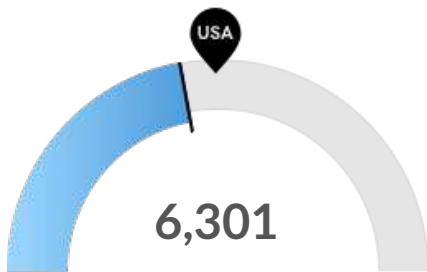
Unemployment Rate Trends

Coshocton County, OH had a September 2022 unemployment rate of 4.59%, **decreasing from 6.79%** 5 years before.



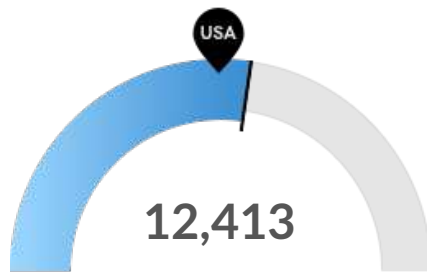

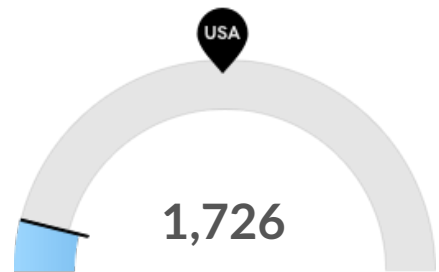
Millennials

Coshocton County, OH has 6,301 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 7,480.



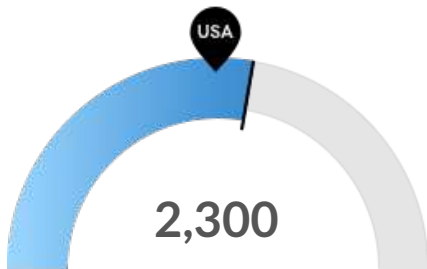
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Coshocton County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 10,884 people 55 or older, while there are 12,413 here.



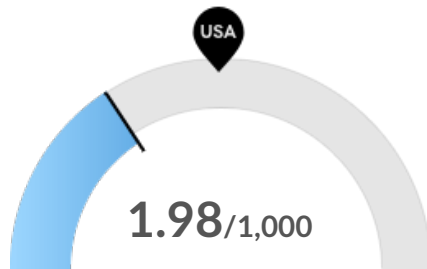
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Coshocton County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 14,901 racially diverse people, while there are 1,726 here.



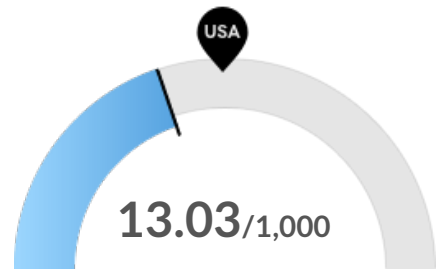
Veterans

Coshocton County, OH has 1.98 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.62 per 1,000 people.

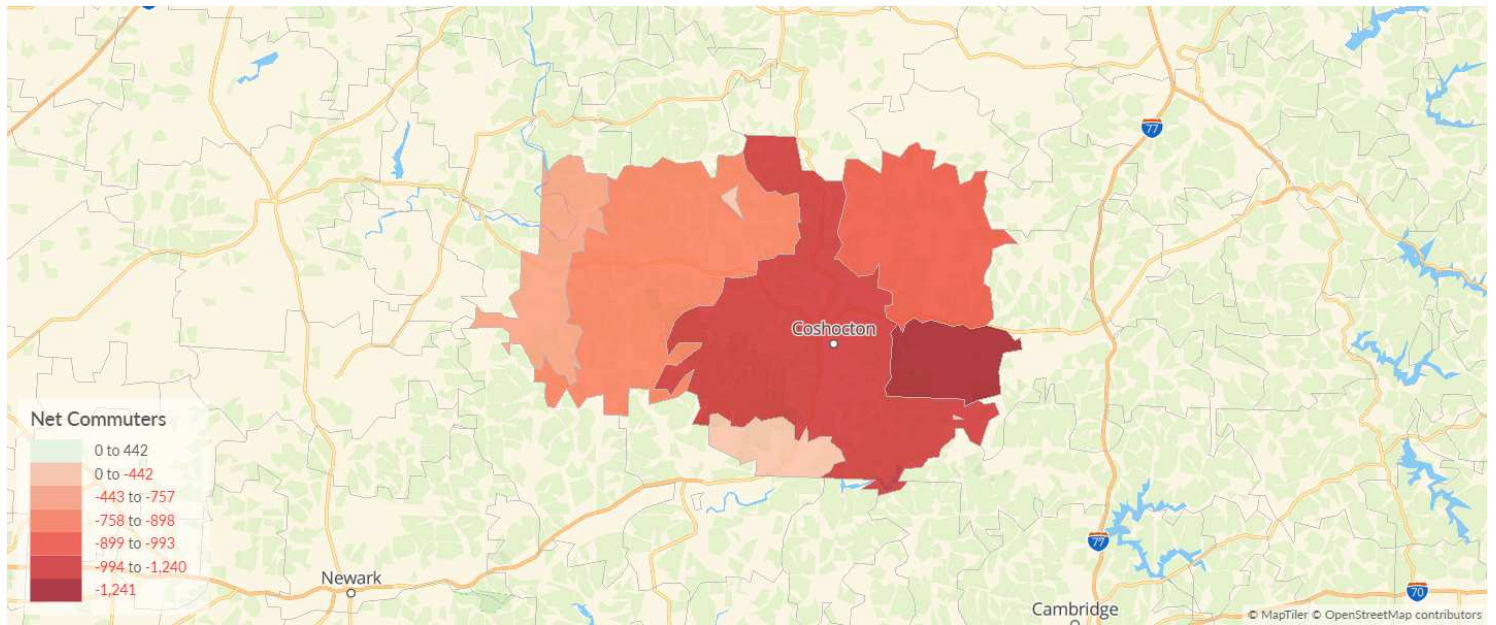


Property Crime

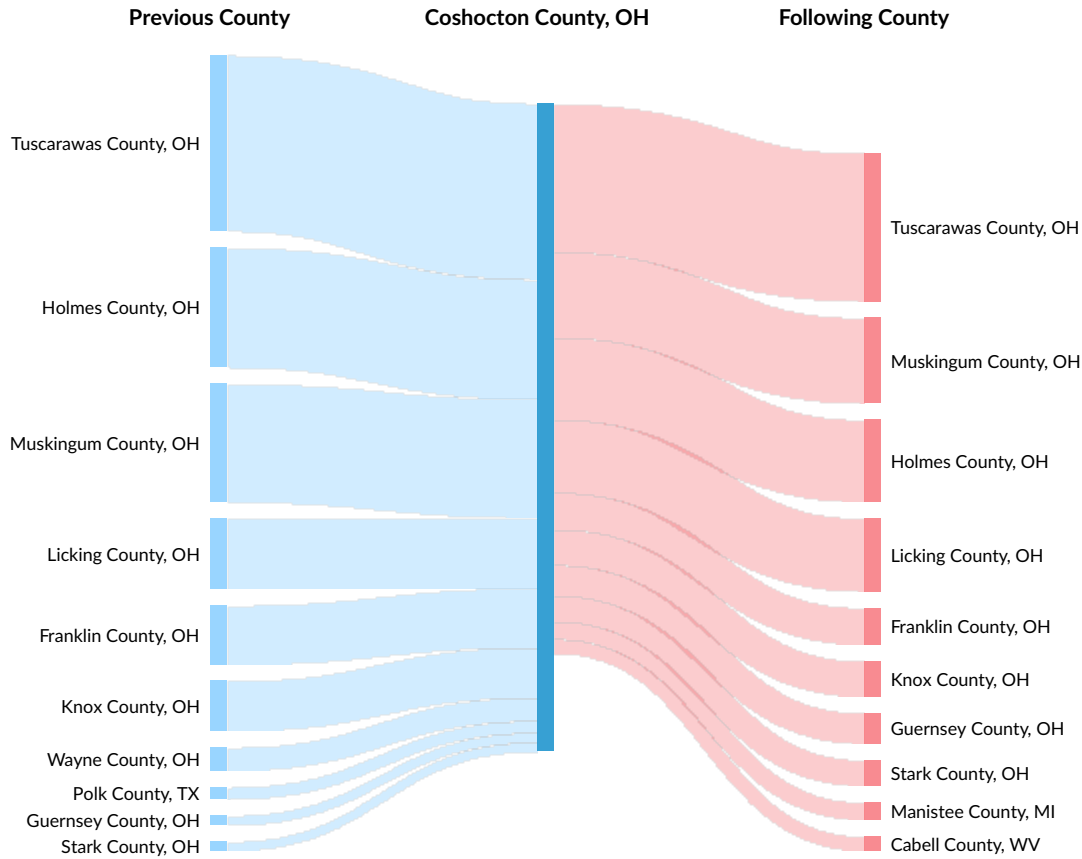

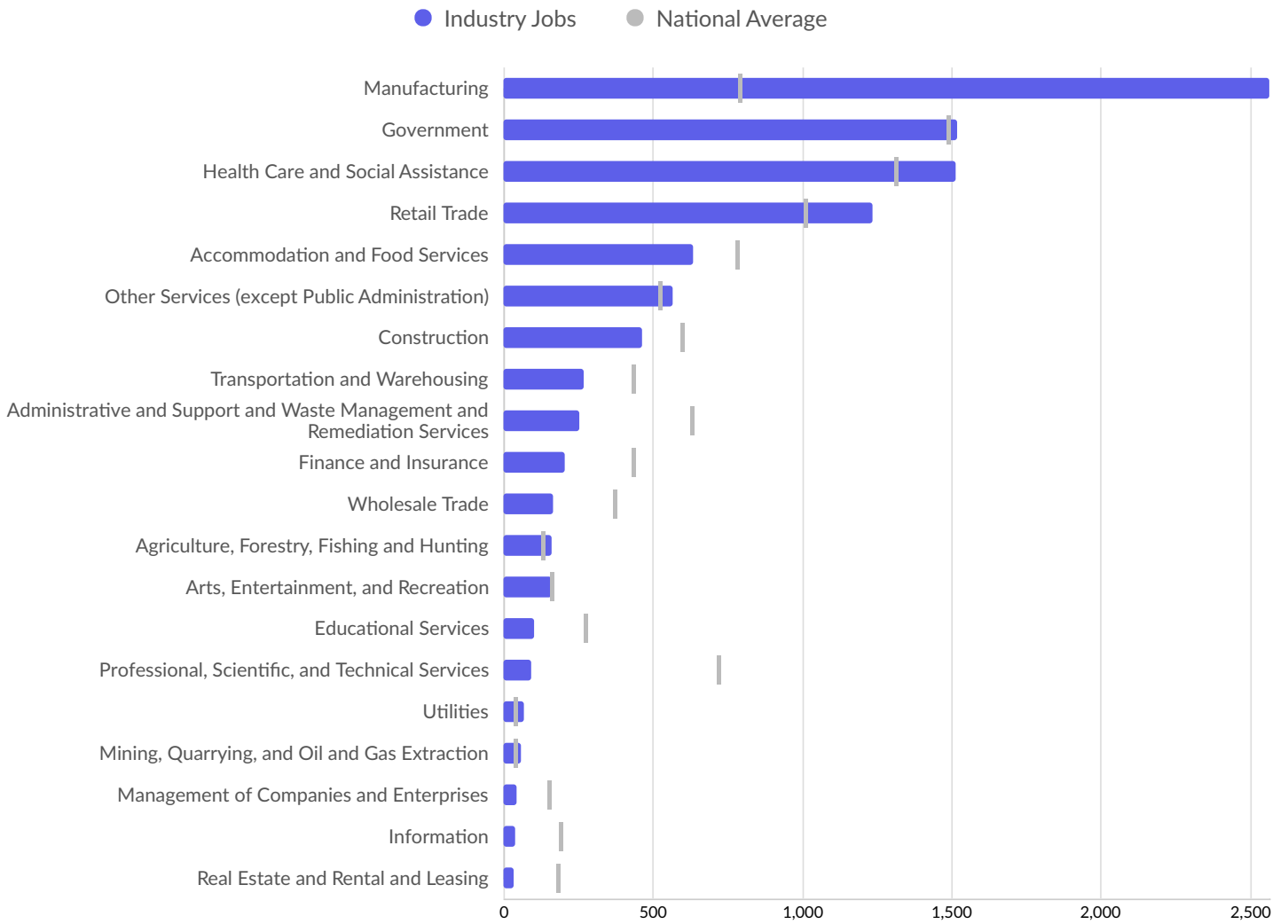

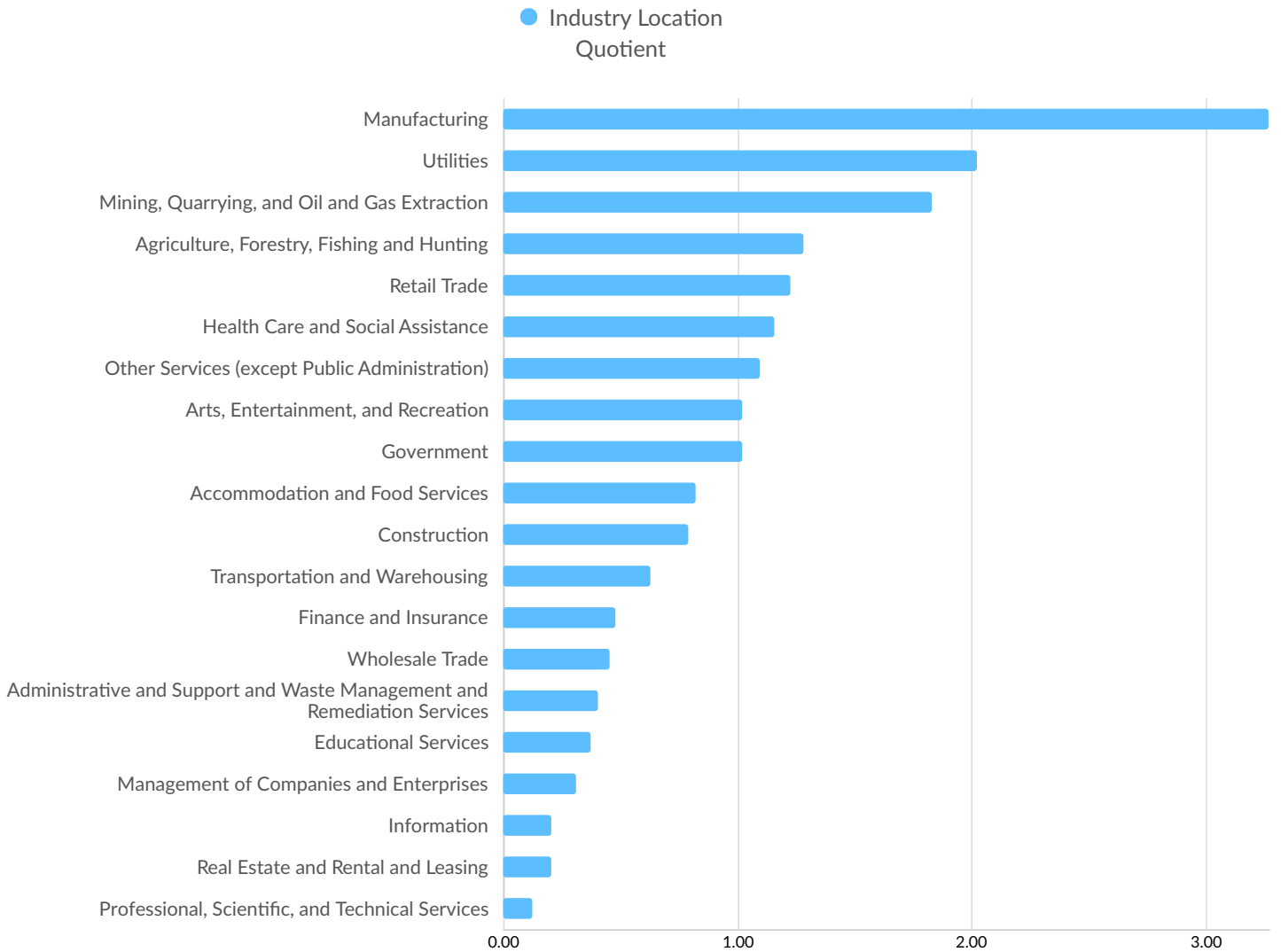

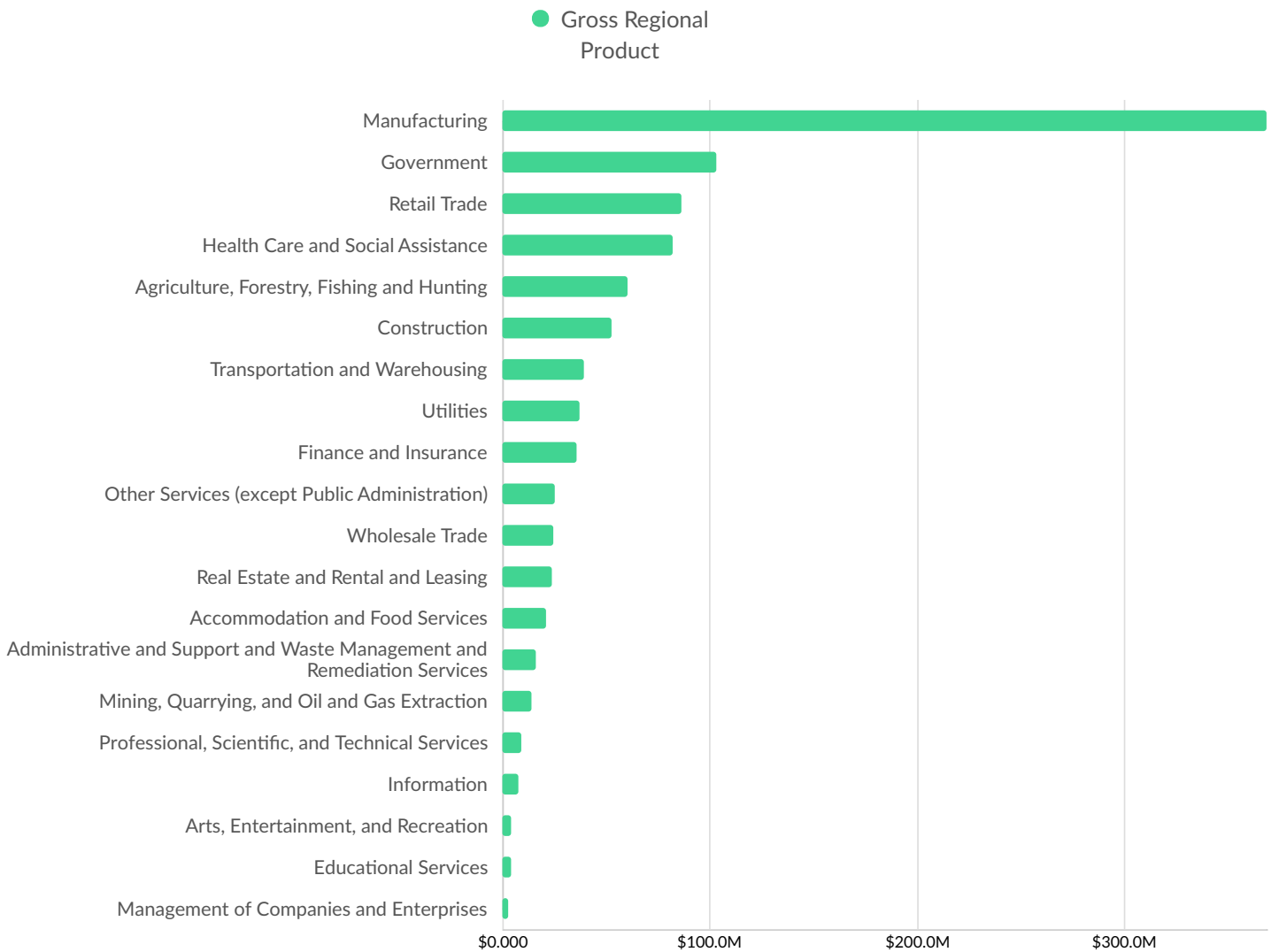
Top Growing Industries



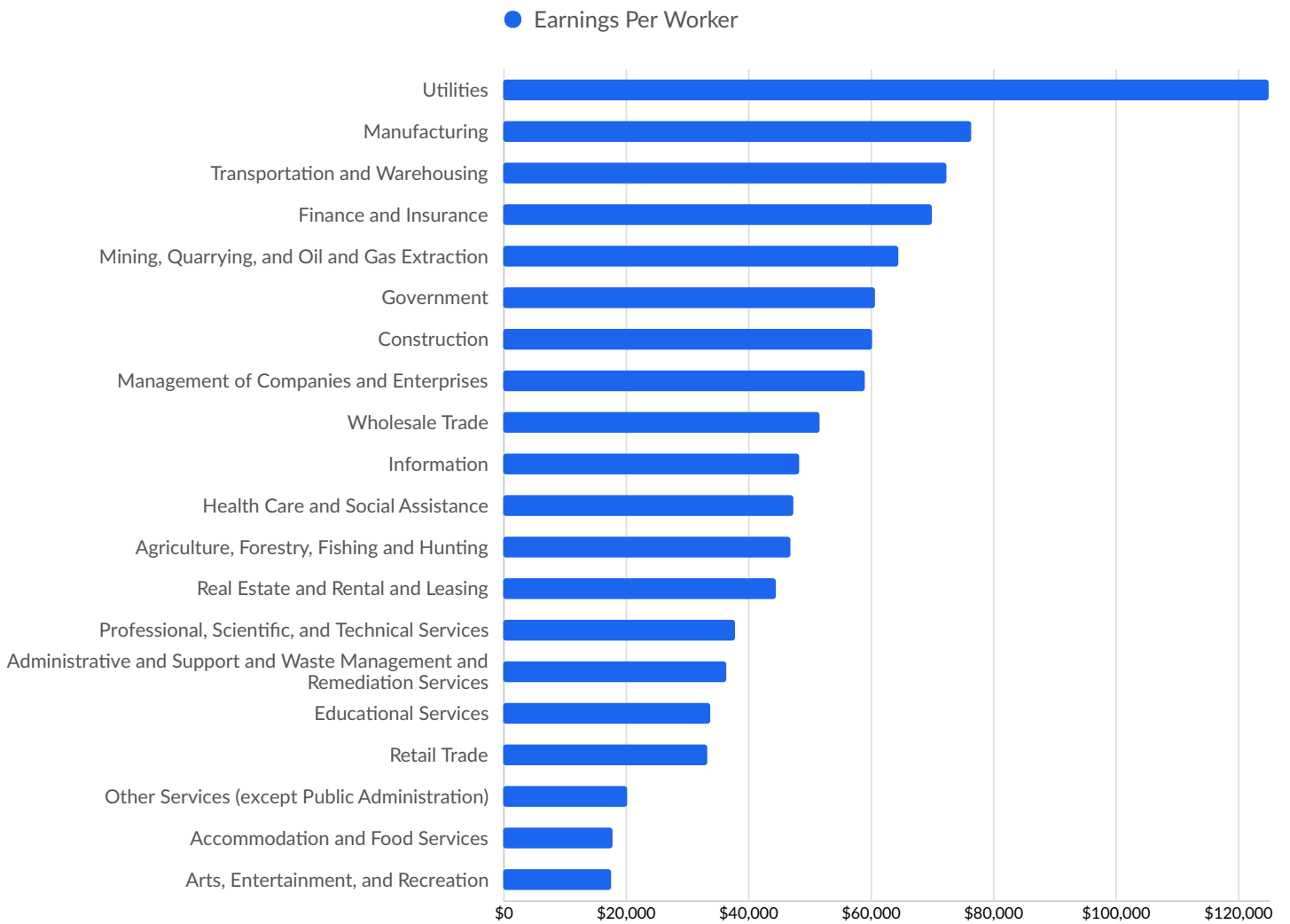
Top Industry Location Quotient

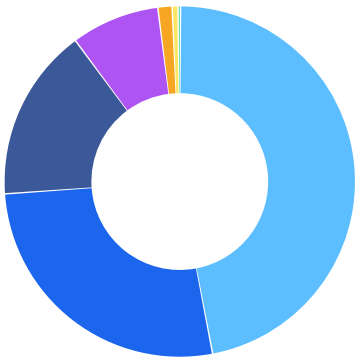

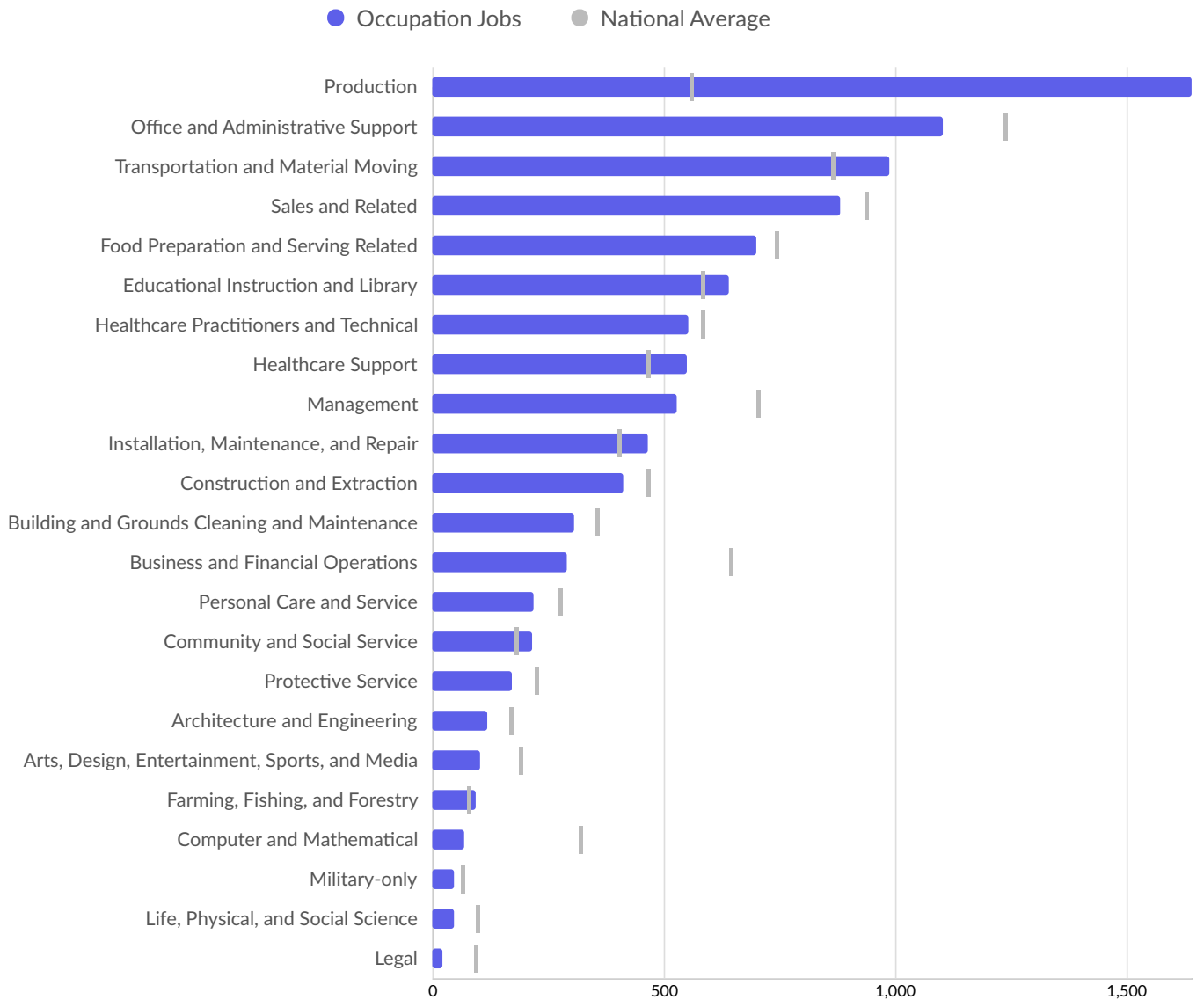

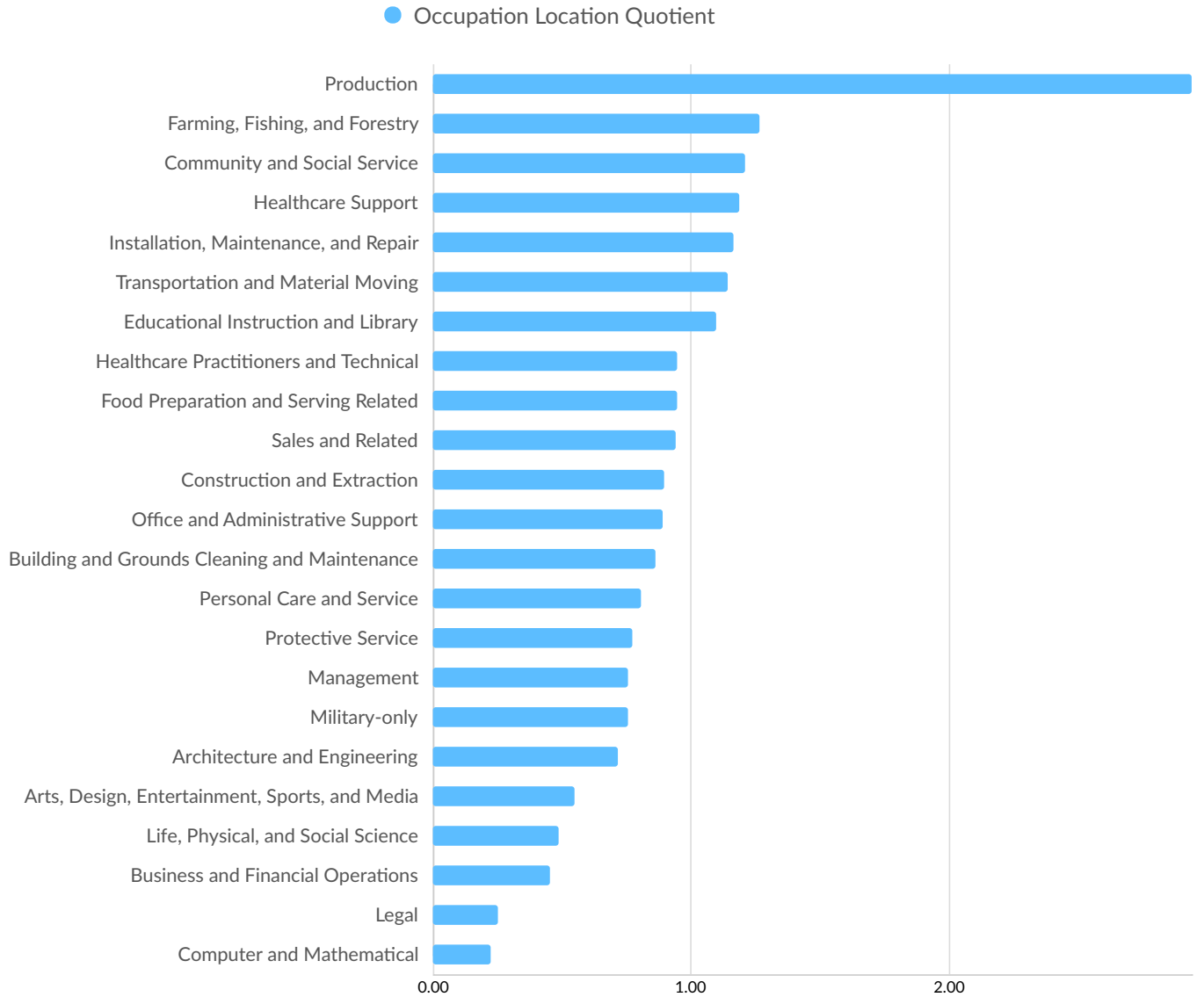

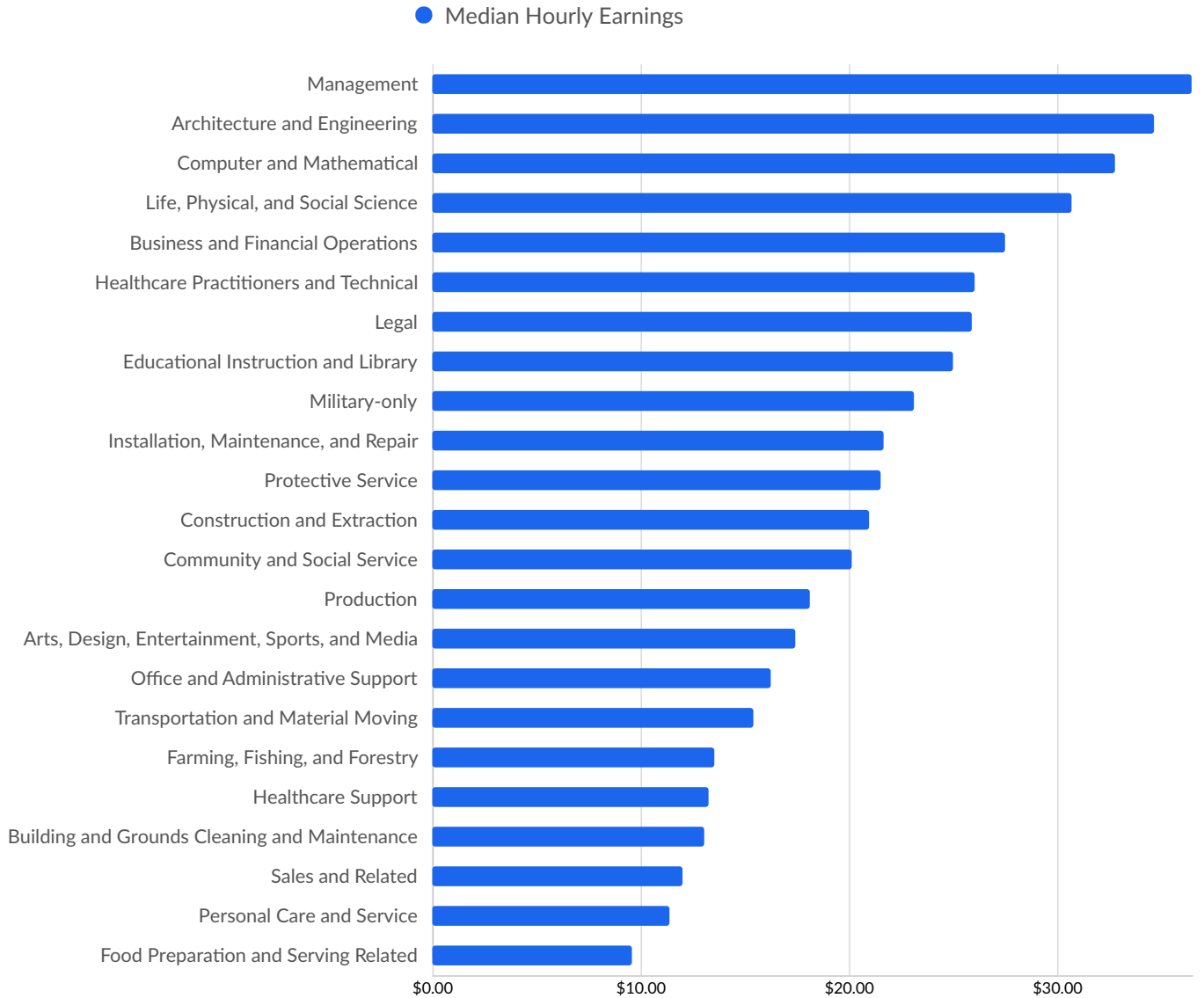
Top Growing Occupations



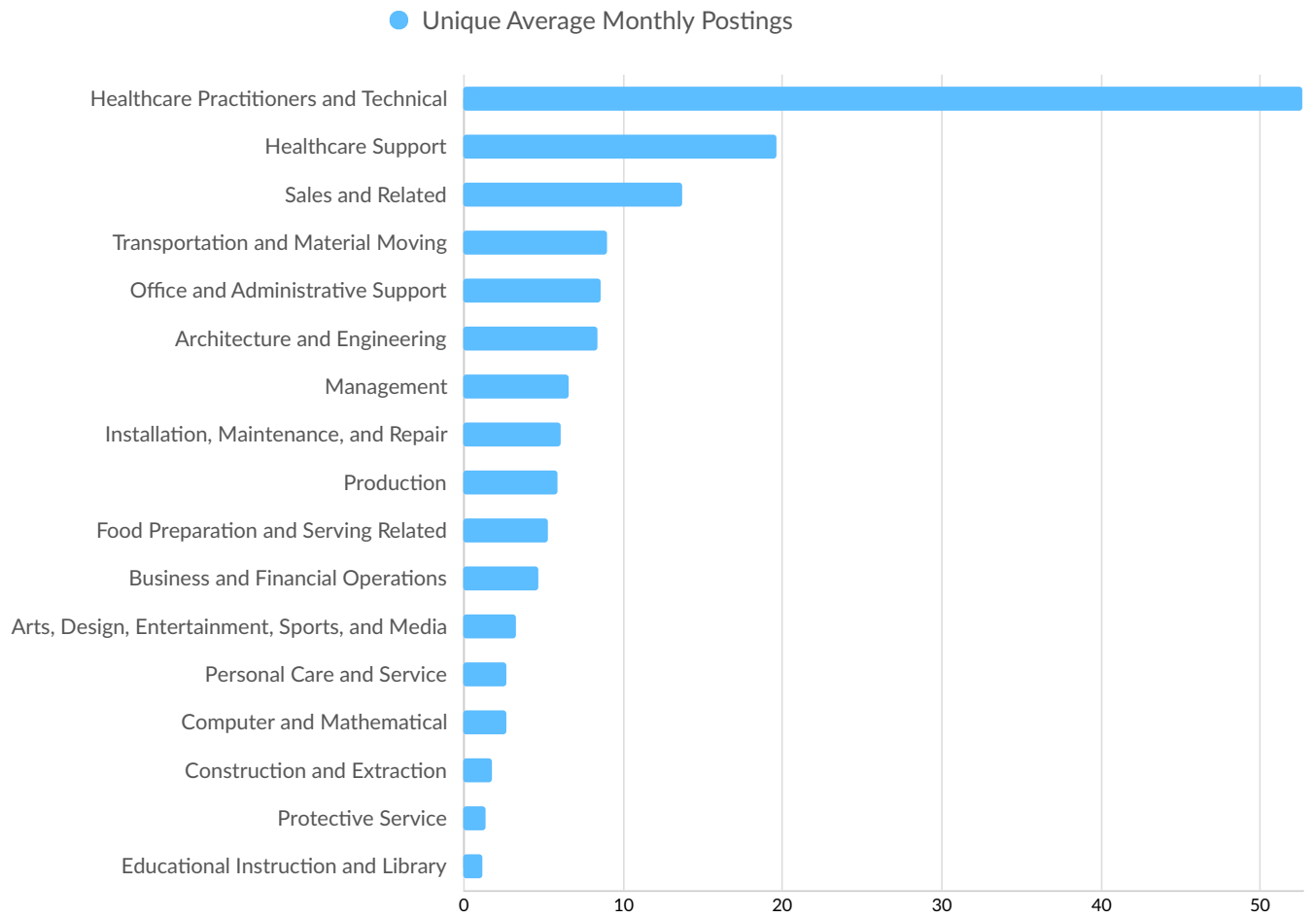
Top Occupation Location Quotient



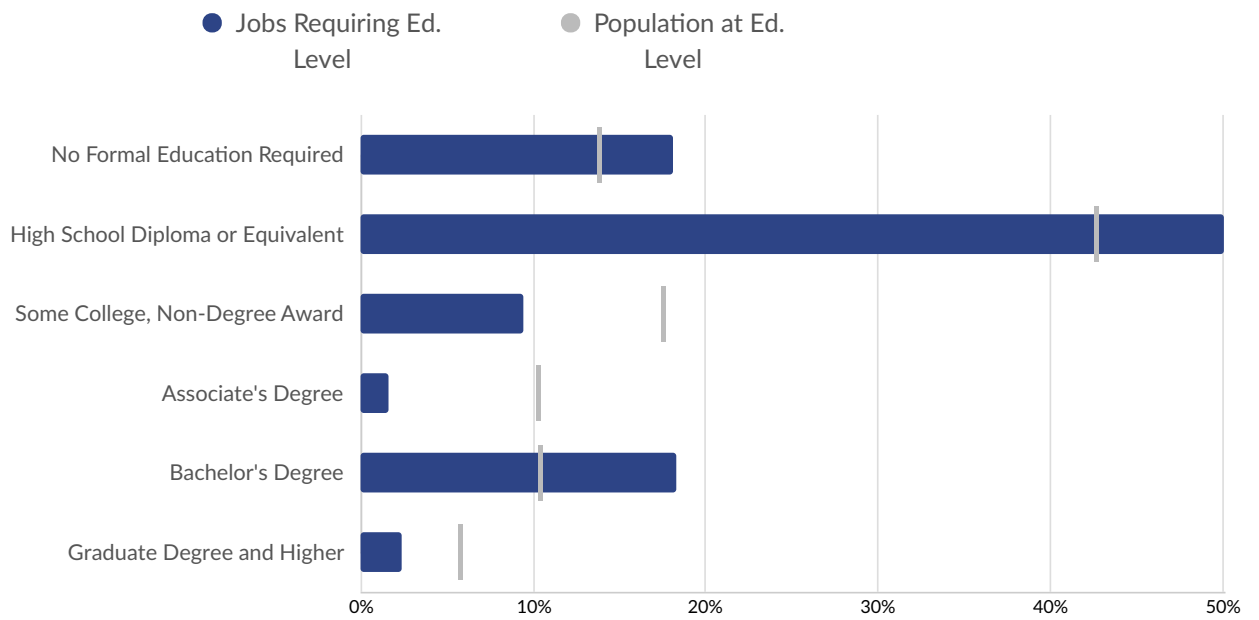
